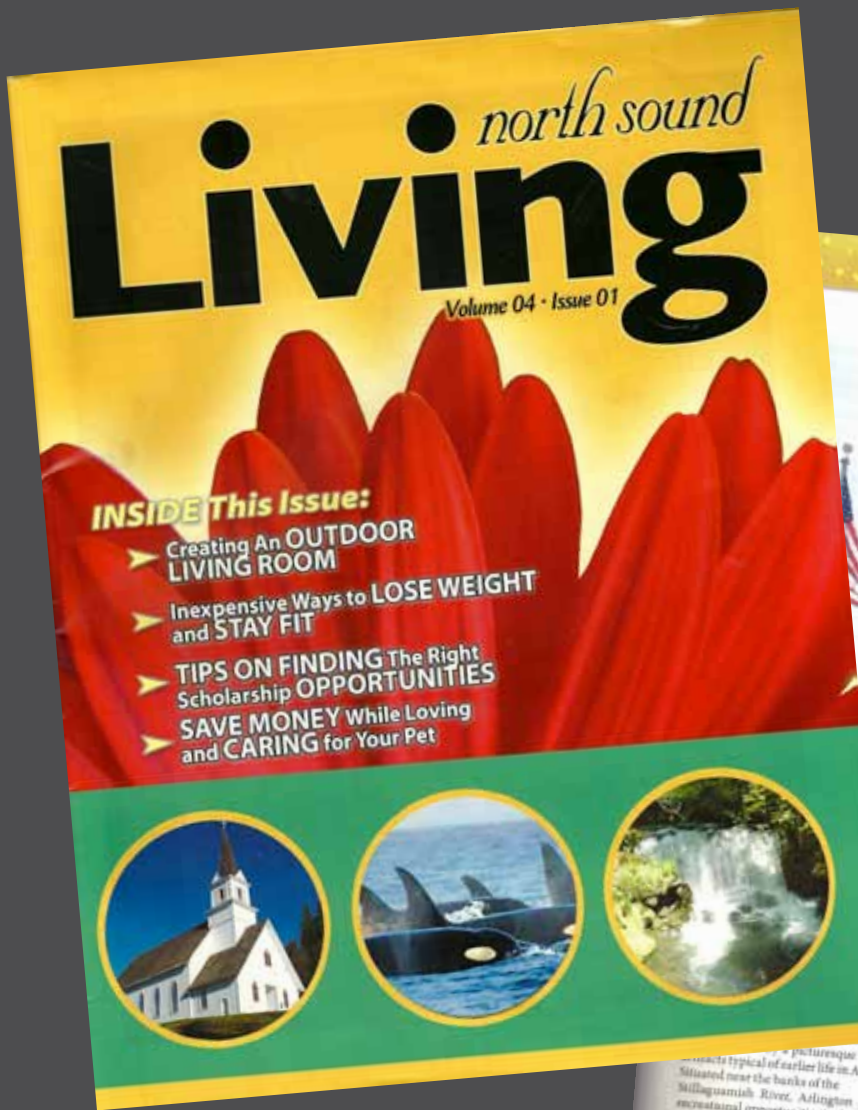

Sedro-Woolley

Known as the Gateway to the Cascades, Sedro-Woolley sits on the banks of the Skagit River along Highway 20 at the western edge of the majestic Cascade Mountains. Its historic downtown is a trip back in time with brick buildings fronted with comfortable wood benches beneath old-fashion light poles. Pictorial on buildings throughout downtown are painted murals, many inspired by Darius Kinsey, a world famous photographer of western scenery, logging and railroads.

Sedro-Woolley's history is born of stubborn determination for a name, as well as prosperity. Founded in 1884 by Mortimer Cook, the town's first postmaster, he discovered that the territory already had a town named Cook, and eventually settled on Cedra, the Spanish word for cedar. That name stuck, but was eventually distorted to Sedro.

Philip Woolley, who created the next town over, was more successful with naming rights when he purchased 84 acres north of Cedra six years later. The two sharply rival towns feuded economically, but finally merged in 1898 to serve the growing population of settlers that included more than 25000 employees of a coal processing plant. Stuck on both names, a hybridation was the result, and Sedro-Woolley came to be.
